6. MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available to all members whose entries have been accepted, at registration at the Warrnambool Yacht Club.

8. RACING AREA

The racing area will be the waters of Lady Bay, Warrnambool, Victoria.

9. COURSES

The courses will be short courses and will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. SCORING

- **10.1 One** race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- **10.2** When four or less races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- **10.3** When five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.

11. SUPPORT BOATS

- **11.1** Support boats shall be marked with a yellow flag.
- **11.2** All support personnel shall keep 100 metres clear of the race area during racing, except when asked to assist by the Race Committee.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. Prizes
